Editorial Information

The journal *Comunicação e Sociedade* welcomes the collaboration of all colleagues, researchers and Professional experts within the field of Communication Sciences. Papers may approach empirical research as well as literature reviews, theoretical models or texts reviews. Authors should follow some editorial rules:

- a) Manuscripts must be sent to: CECS@ics.uminho.pt. Thematic issues are to be coordinated directly and therefore the manuscripts must be sent to the coordinator.
- b) Three paper copies must be posted to the following address: Centro de Estudos de Comunicação e Sociedade, Instituto de Ciências Sociais, Universidade do Minho, Campus de Gualtar, 4710-057 Braga.
- c) Manuscripts will be typed in double space, A4 normalized white sheets, in Times New Roman, 12. Illustrations, charts and drawings should be at the end of the text, in separate sheets. Electronic manuscripts will be Word processed (either Windows or Mac). Charts must include the figures in order to allow for re-editing if necessary.
- d) Manuscripts will include an abstract (max. 1 000 characters) in original language and also in English. Full texts should not overcome 50 000 characters (including spaces).
- e) Some ID elements must be sent in a separate page. This will include: Title, names and institutions of the authors, key-words (Max.5). Full name and address, phone n., fax, e-mail of the person responsible for the manuscript
- f) Pattern for quotes and references are the following: (Berten, 2001); (Winseck & Cuthbert, 1997); (Gudykunst *et al.*, 1996). These will match the bibliographic references presented at the final pages as follows:

- g) Authors are full responsible for the published papers.
- h) Authors will receive the drafts (including charts and images) for correction and must return them two weeks after their reception.
- i) Authors will receive a copy of the journal where their work was published.
- j) *Comunicação e Sociedade* welcomes all collaboration. However we do not take the responsibility for non requested manuscripts, which will not be returned to the authors.
- k) Manuscripts will be double-blind peer reviewed previously to publication.
